




Described as an intelligent love story in a cold war climate this book captures the essence and madness of a consuming and illicit passion.


Quite honesty is a comic novel with entertaining reflections on crime. John Mortimer is the author of the popular *Rumpole* series




A political thriller giving the fictional account of a ghostwriter who has been hired to write the autobiography of a British P.M.




The Book Thief is the story of a young girl, her family and the boxer in their basement as they struggle to survive in Nazi Germany .





On Chesil Beach is a tale that traces the story of a young couple on their wedding night. A novel of remarkable depth.




Cheating at Canasta is another gem of a collection of short stories from one of the masters of the genre William Trevor. Highly recommended
